### **MAYOR DEMARIA AND PRESIDENT OF GLOBAL VISION CELEBRATE GRAND OPENING OF ENVISION HOTEL IN EVERETT**

Last year on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Mayor Carlo DeMaria and President of Global Vision Hotels, Gautam Sharma broke down walls to signify the ground breaking for the enVision Hotel. Almost a year to the date this week, on Monday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017, they officially cut the ribbon for the new hotel in Everett.

This 101-room boutique hotel features a rich Everett history inspired vintage design with a modern technology twist. The hotel was specifically designed for travelers, who are seeking a unique Boston experience with a boutique neighborhood charm featuring a café and lounge. Just four miles outside of Boston and the close proximity to Logan International Airport, enVision Hotel will attract many travelers to Everett.

The grand opening ceremony event featured Mayor DeMaria presenting a gift of an old sewing machine with the date and brief message to the enVision Hotel staff. There were also kind remarks from the State Senator, State Representative, Chamber of Commerce, and the President of Global Vision Hotels, Gautam Sharma. The speakers highlighted the key elements of the hotel as well as the growth of Everett as a destination for business and millennial travelers.
