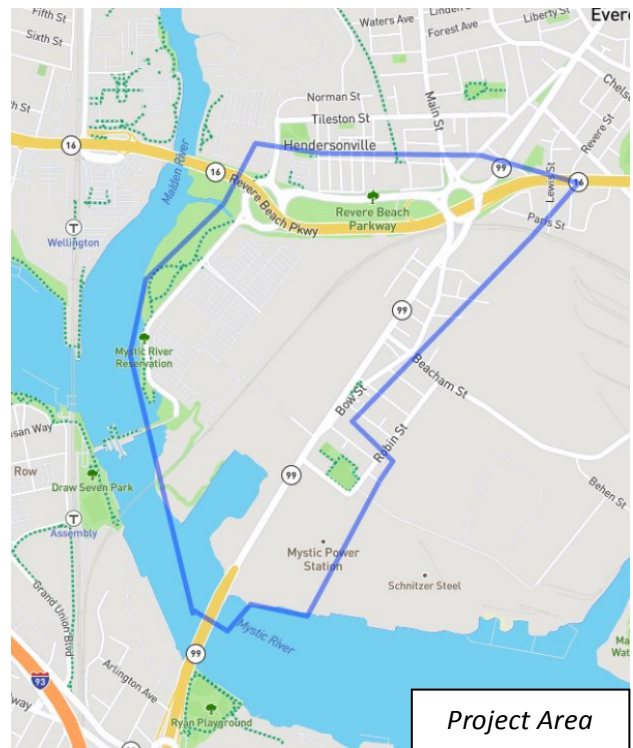

The purpose of this meeting is to provide residents, abutters, and other interested parties with an opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Northern Strand Community Trail Extension project and the team assembled by the City of Everett to undertake the next phase of expanding the path from its current terminus at West Street in Everett to the Mystic River near the Wynn Casino. The meeting will focus on existing conditions and obtaining public ideas and input. Following a brief presentation, project staff will lead a discussion to answer questions.

The Northern Strand Community Trail is a walking and cycling trail roughly 10 miles long which currently extends from West Street in the center of Everett to the Lynn Commons through Malden, Revere and Saugus. The City of Everett is undertaking a project to extend the path from its current ending place at West Street to the Mystic River. When added to other improvements either already underway or in planning, the Northern Strand Path will connect users to Wynn Boston Harbor, the Gateway Shopping Center, and downtown Boston as well as the MBTA Assembly Row station and proposed paths in Somerville and Charlestown.
