DEMARIA BRINGS FREE CULINARY ARTS TRAINING PROGRAM TO EVERETT

Mayor Carlo DeMaria recently announced that his administration has championed an excellent opportunity for Everett residents looking to break into the hospitality industry at Wynn or anywhere else.

Mayor DeMaria has partnered with NECAT to bring a free Culinary Arts Job Training Program to Everett to help unemployed adults prepare for a career in the culinary industry. This 16-week program provides students with extensive training and helps graduates secure permanent jobs.

Mayor Carlo DeMaria said, “My top priority is to ensure that Everett residents have the opportunity to succeed, have a career and raise a family right here in Everett. The NECAT program can be that opportunity. I hope our residents will take advantage of it.”

NECAT is currently recruiting for its first culinary arts training program at Everett High School, set to begin Oct. 30. This Everett program is an expansion of its current Boston-based program. The program is supported by the Mass. Gaming Commission’s Community Mitigation Fund and is offered at no cost to students.
