MAYOR DEMARIA ANNOUNCES ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN UP FOR APRIL 22

Mayor Carlo DeMaria would like to invite residents to help out the City for its annual Spring Clean Up event on Earth Day - Saturday, April 22nd from 8 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. All residents and community members are encouraged to attend, and will come together in an effort to prepare and clean the Northern Strand's Bike to Sea Trail. The Bike to Sea Trail is currently a community pathway stretching from Everett through Malden, Revere, and Saugus toward the Lynn waterfront.

Volunteers will help remove debris, rake and sweep, as well as plant the community rain gardens that are currently stationed at the corner of West and Wellington of the Bike Path. Those that plan to attend will be asked to meet at the City Services Parking Lot located at 19 Norman Street at 8 a.m. Pre-registration can be found on the City's website by visiting www.cityofeverett.com/cleanup, however walk-in volunteers may arrive day-of event at the meeting location. T-shirts will be provided for those that plan to help.

Following the clean up, there will be a post-celebration held at Bone Up Brewery parking lot (38 Norman Street) for a free outdoor lunch and concert featuring The Local Scruff, who will begin playing at 1 p.m.
