CITY OF EVERETT TO PARTICIPATE IN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DRILL

Mayor Carlo DeMaria and the Everett Health Department will participate in an Emergency Preparedness drill with the Office of Emergency Preparedness and Emergency Management from the Department of Public Health on Friday May 19, 2017. The drill will be located at the Connolly Center on Chelsea street, from 7:30am-12 noon.

This is only a drill to examine the procedures that would have to be activated in the event of a real emergency. Staff from the Health Department along with volunteers and other City Departments will stage a full-scale exercise at this time. Other members of Emergency Coalitions will also be observing.

You may see an increase in activity in this area during the drill. Remember this is only a drill. There should be no interference with daily routines.
