An Ordinance – C0032-14

Be it Ordained by the CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVERETT, as follows:

That Chapter II, Section 21A of the Revised and Consolidated Ordinances of the City of Everett, as amended, is further amended by striking out the Section and inserting in place thereof the following:

All permanent full-time non-union and administrative officers and employees shall receive a longevity payment as follows:

10 years service	\$400
15 years service	\$650
20 years service	\$850

All permanent full-time non-union and administrative officers and employees that are department heads shall receive a longevity payment as follows:

10 years service	\$800
15 years service	\$1,300
20 years service	\$1,700

Payment shall be made on the anniversary date of employment. If an officer or employee terminates service, by death or retirement, they shall be entitled to a pro-rated payment based on the number of whole months of service since the previous anniversary date.
