4. Frank Diliberto, Matt Dugan, Lyndsey Coburn of Distrigas made a brief presentation for a proposed on-land mooring dolphin installation. The dolphin would be adjacent to the existing Everett Marine Terminal. The project would install a cast iron bollard on a concrete cap within an existing concrete slab. This bollard will provide an optimal mooring point for vessels berthing at the terminal. Commissioners previously reviewed the application and Commissioner Carl Colson and Agent Philbin performed a site visit. A motion made by Eamon Kernan to issue a standard Order of Conditions for the new mooring installation. Seconded by Rita Hashem. All Commissioners voted in favor.

Eamon Kernan made a motion to continue the public hearing until the next commission meeting on February 17th at 7pm, for the Notice of Intent for the proposed subsurface borings and sediment probes for the planned riverfront boardwalk at Gateway Park.
