
2. **C0097-22** Ordinance/s/ Councilor Anthony DiPierro

An ordinance redefining the mayor's annual longevity bonus payment

Councilors debated the merits of this piece after hearing from the public at public participation. The Council made this amendment to the ordinance as a compromise to the previous ordinance and to make the longevity bonus the amount approved by the Council back in 2016 which was to give the mayor a longevity bonus of \$2,500 per year a total of \$10,000 at the end of a mayoral term. Councilor Marchese and Smith believe that the position of mayor does not require a longevity bonus and getting re-elected is the bonus you receive. Councilors DiPierro and Lattanzi believe there needs to be a compromise and that a 5 term mayor is worth more than a 1 term mayor. Councilor Le made a motion to amend the item but the chair did not hear a second. Councilor DiPierro called for the question and a vote was taken to enroll the ordinance.
