- III. **Approval of minutes from last meeting:** Approved by Board
- IV. **Open Issues:** Sgt. Gaff informed the commission that Nichols St. is under a study to see possibility of making it a One Way and Englewood Ave will have parking spots painted
- V. **New Business:**
- a. HP request for 79 Revere St was **DENIED** by the Disability Commission as they own the home and have a driveway
  - b. Request for 15 or 30 minute parking in the block of 144 Ferry St to help out the business that are struggling in the area **APPROVED 3 spots (for 1 year) Mon-Sat 9AM-5PM**
  - c. Request for 15 minute parking at 208 Ferry St for Moreno Barber Shop **Approved for 1 hour**
  - d. LUMA is requesting 30 minute parking at 198 Ferry St to facilitate drop off and food distribution (per Councilor Stephanie Martins) **APPROVED 2 spots Mon-Sat 9AM-5PM**
  - e. Discuss the ordinance regarding taxi/livery plate. Resident feels he should be able to get a sticker for his taxi (QAlert) **TABLED for further discussion**
  - f. 31 Summer St is requesting a 30-minute parking for her Hair Removal business **DENIED**
  - g. Discuss corner parking on Parlin and Main (QAlert) **Two weeks of Direct Patrol**
  - h. Resident requesting white lines to be repainted for parking availability at corner of School St and Hazel Park **Also include Prescott near Airforce Rd REFER to Engineering**
  - i. Resident request a "No Parking Here to Corner" sign by Bellingham Ave and Main St
  - j. Resident request a speed study on Lexington St. **APPROVED**
  - k. Resident request clear signage at 949 Broadway "Do Not Block the Driveway" **Direct Patrol**
  - l. Resident requesting another speed bump or raising the existing one on Bow St **DENIED**
  - m. Discuss hiring new Parking Enforcement for overnight **TABLED for further discussion**
  - n. Increase parking fines, especially for overnight parking **TABLED for further discussion**
