- A. Total Wine and Spirits – Change of Manager to Marc Javery. A motion was made by Mike Dantone and seconded by Phil Arloro and approved. 2 yays 0 nays

- B. Rumors Bar & Grill, 56 Ferry Street, transfer of License. Neighbors from Orange Court appeared to express their concerns about the loud music, parking, and customer behavior when leaving the business. The Board explains that once the license is approved, they will have to close at 12:00 AM for the first six months, the last will be one hour before closing. Once the six-month probation is up, they can then come before the Board to request the hours to be extended to 1:00 AM. No minors are allowed in the business after 9:00 PM, no dancing will be allowed because this would give the impression that the business is a night club which it is not, it is a restaurant. Signs should be posted stating no parking on Orange Court. They will have to take the curtains down and check the decibels every hour outside. Mike Dantone made a motion, seconded by Phil Arloro, and approved.
