Minutes of the Meeting: A motion was made by Mike Dantone and seconded by Phil Arloro to approve the minutes from September 5, 2023.

Regular Business:

1. Short Term Rental for 28 County Rd, The License Board will no longer be hearing Short Term Rental application. Once the ordinance is changed it will be issued by the Building Dept.
2. Mama Santos Café, 386 Main St., was in for a disturbance on August 20, that police had to respond to. Chairman Antonelli reads the police report. Jaquelyn states that the fight started outside and then ended up in the back of the bar. Councilor Lattanzi stated that he has had numerous complaints from neighbors about the loud music and he does not want a nightclub in their neighborhood. His suggestion was to roll back their hours. The officers who were at the scene said that the individuals that were fighting were intoxicated. Phil Arloro states that Jaquelyn should have better control of her business.

A motion was made by Phil Arloro to roll back the hours to 12:00 AM starting on September 18, 2023, which will remain in effect until a business plan is submitted to the Board and approved. Jaquelyn is to send in the receipts from the security company, and the invoices from the camera company showing the dates that the camera was repaired, there will be no use of the back porch at all. She is also required to check the decibels inside her business and outside the door when it is closed.

Motion seconded by Mike Dantone. The board voted 3 yays – 0 nays and passed.
