- I. **Call to Order:** Sgt. Gaff called the Traffic Commission meeting to order at 6:00 PM

- III. **Approval of minutes from last meeting:** Approved by Board
- IV. **Open Issues:**
 On July 24th a letter was sent to Englewood Ave residents informing them that the Engineering Dept is looking for proper weather and timing to get parking spots painted. On August 30th a letter was sent informing Englewood Ave residents that Engineering Dept has determined that painting parking spots on both sides of the streets would impede the flow of traffic
- V. **New Business:**
 - a. Discuss problems at corner of Bellingham Ave and Main St (parking) **PLACE "No Parking Here to Corner" sign**
 - b. Request to replace traffic light at corner of Springvale Ave & Elm St. **PLACE "Flashing Crosswalk" sign**
