A motion is made by Mike Dantone to open the meeting at 6:30 PM

Minutes of the Meeting: A motion was made by Mike Dantone and seconded by Phil Arloro to approve the minutes from September 18, 2023.

Regular Business:

1. Bone-Up Brewing, appeared for noise complaints over the summer. Jared from Bone-up states that as of December 31, 2023, they will be closing permanently. Acting Chairman Phil Arloro told Jared that until then there is to be no more outdoor music.
2. Winners Sports Bar & Grill, Tony Portillo, and his Attorney Niles Welch appeared for a Pledge of Collateral. Mike Dantone and seconded by Phil Arloro to approve the Pledge. They also appeared for the use of the basement. The Board voted and approved the opening of the basement with the following stipulations:
 1. The basement will be used for public use. All patrons will be twenty-one or older and must show a legal ID before entering.
 2. Dancing will be prohibited. Winners understand that it is their responsibility to ensure that their patrons abide by this rule.
 3. No live entertainment of any kind. Recorded music will be permitted but the use of a microphone for any type of announcement is prohibited.
 4. All emergency egress must be clear at all times both inside and out.
 5. The point of sale and camera system must be active in the basement and Winners agrees to provide the Police Department or Licensing Board access, should there be any incidents.
 6. All patrons must be out of the basement 30 minutes prior to the posted license hours.
 7. An electrical relay will be installed within the next 90 days. The switch will be located at the top of the basement stairs and will kill the recorded music and turn on all the basement lights if there is an emergency.
3. A motion was made to refer the banning of nips to the administration for a public hearing.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting.

Meeting adjourned
