Regular Business:

- A. An application has been presented to the License Commission from the Basna Club, 36 Ferry St, for a Change of License Type from a Club License to a Restaurant License. The Board explain that once the request is approved by the ABCC they must open to the public and start serving food. Hours will be Sunday 9am – 1pm, closed on Mondays, Tuesday to Saturday 9am-9pm. - B. - C. Josie's Place, 281 Main St. for the status of the sale. Josie says that once she reopens that she will run the bar and Max will be the manager. The Chairman makes a recommendation to Josie that she should hire an attorney for the purchase and sales agreement if she plans on selling the bar.
