About the Program

The North Suburban Consortium (NSC) utilizes Federal grant funds from the HOME Investment Partnerships program to provide down payment assistance loans (DPA). **Effective 7/1/2024, DPA loan for market rate properties can be up to \$10,000.00 and for NSC HOME-subsidized property, up to \$5,000.00 (amount determined after underwriting is completed).** Program goals are to strengthen public-private partnerships to expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary and affordable housing for low and moderate income homebuyers.

- Assistance available to income-eligible first time homebuyer applicants (one who has had no homeownership interest in a principal
 residence during the past 3 years or a displaced homemaker or single parent who has only owned a home with a former spouse
 while married).
- Assistance provided on a first-come, first-served basis, upon receipt of completed application, supporting documentation and determination of eligibility until funding is exhausted.

Eligible Property

To be eligible, property must be:

- Located in an NSC community: Arlington, Chelsea, Everett, Malden, Medford, Melrose, Revere, Winthrop.
- Occupied by income-eligible persons as described below.
- Single-family home, condominium or townhouse (multi-family properties not eligible).

- gifted money, including gifts of equity,
- other forms of capital investments,
- retirement accounts such as 401K, 403B, 457 and IRA accounts,
- Roth IRAs,
- real property (whole or partial interest).

Excluded assets:

- government approved college savings plan,
- municipally funded buydowns,
- community, municipal or employer funded down payment or closing cost assistance that meets Fannie Mae's definition of a Community Seconds Program.

Other Requirements

- Applicant must complete a FTHB counseling workshop offered by a HUD-certified organization or agency
- Minimum credit score 620
- Maximum housing to income ratio 35%

- Maximum total debt to income ratio 50%
- Properties located in a flood zone will be required to have flood insurance
- Homes constructed prior to 1978 are subject to HUD Lead-Based Paint Requirements in addition to passing Housing Quality Standards Inspection.
- Applicant (buyer) cannot leave the closing transaction with excess funds. Either the primary mortgage loan amount can be reduced or NSC DPA will be reduced. Final closing disclosure must be provided for NSC review prior to closing date.

The HQS inspection will be performed by the NSC through its designated entities prior to the acquisition at no cost to the buyer or seller.

If the house does not pass HOS, the Housing Rehabilitation Inspector will create a list of necessary work and a cost estimate. If it is determined that the buyer can reasonably undertake the work necessary to meet HQS, the buyer can sign a statement of their intention to complete the work within six months. If more substantial work is needed, the buyer must either apply to the Purchase and Rehabilitation loan program or select another home.

The HQS inspection will be made of readily accessible areas of the building and is limited to visual observation or apparent conditions existing at the time of the inspection only. Latent and concealed defects and deficiencies are excluded from the inspection: equipment and systems will not be dismantled. The HQS inspection is not a guarantee or warranty of the adequacy, performance or condition of any structure, item or system at the property address.

Line 1b. Enter your employer identification number (EIN) if your request relates to a business return. Otherwise, enter the first social security number (SSN) or your individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN) shown on the return. For example, if you are requesting Form 1040 that includes Schedule C (Form 1040), enter your SSN.

Line 3. Enter your current address. If you use a P.O. box, include it on this line.

Line 4. Enter the address shown on the last return filed if different from the address entered on line 3.

Note: If the addresses on lines 3 and 4 are different and you have not changed your address with the IRS, file Form 8822-Change of Address. For a business address, file Form 8822-B, Change of Address or Responsible Party — Business.

Line 5b. Enter up to 10 numeric characters to create a unique customer file number that will appear on the transcript. The customer file number <u>should not</u> contain an SSN. Completion of this line is not required.

Signature and date. Form 4506-T must be signed and dated by the taxpayer listed on line 1a or 2a. The IRS must receive Form 4506-T within 120 days of the date signed by the taxpayer or it will be rejected. Ensure that all applicable lines are completed before signing.



You must check the box in the signature area to acknowledge you have the authority to sign and request the information. The form will not be processed and returned to you if the box is unchecked.

Individuals. Transcripts of jointly filed tax returns may be furnished to either spouse. Only one signature is required. Sign Form 4506-T exactly as your name appeared on the original return. If you changed your name, also sign your current name.

Corporations. Generally, Form 4506-T can be signed by: (1) an officer having legal authority to bind the corporation, (2) any person designated by the board of directors or other governing body, or (3) any officer or employee on written request by any principal officer and attested to by the secretary or other officer. A bona fide shareholder of record owning 1 percent or more of the outstanding stock of the corporation may submit a Form 4506-T but must provide documentation to support the requester's right to receive the information.

Partnerships. Generally, Form 4506-T can be signed by any person who was a member of the partnership during any part of the tax period requested on line 9.

All others. See section 6103(e) if the taxpayer has died, is insolvent, is a dissolved corporation, or if a trustee, guardian, executor, receiver, or administrator is acting for the taxpayer.

Note: If you are Heir at law, Next of kin, or Beneficiary you must be able to establish a material interest in the estate or trust.

Documentation. For entities other than individuals, you must attach the authorization document. For example, this could be the letter from the principal officer authorizing an employee of the corporation or the letters testamentary authorizing an individual to act for an estate.
