Presentation was made by Adam Marchionda of Marchionda and Associates, L.P. representing Gabriel Silva for consideration of a Request for a Determination of Applicability for the proposed demolition of a two-family home and attached garage located at 19 Paris Street and construction of a four story, 5-unit townhouse.
