 - f) Discuss the traffic light at the intersection of Appleton St. and Main St. should have its function changed so it operates only as a means to allow a walk light to operate. This light should not have a stop and go cycle. This light constantly causes traffic to back up on to Tileston St. due to the cars parking on top of the trip wire on Appleton St **(will be included in the redesigned project of Main St) TABLED**
 - g) Discuss the traffic light at the intersection of Second St. and Broadway must be timed properly so as to stop the grid lock caused by cars turning left off Chelsea St. onto Broadway. Plus, the green light cycle is too long on Corey St. This traffic light needs to be timed to the satisfaction of the Traffic Comm.
