 - b. Discuss commercial plates and regular vehicles

 - d. Discuss the fire station at Ferry St the do not block the box is the length of the fire station and the house next to it. impeding more traffic flow lately all the way to the Chelsea St rotary and obstructing the cars that can take a right turn on red (per member F Cafasso)
 - e. Discuss how things can be done better for future snow storms (per member F. Cafasso)
 - f. Discuss the traffic light at the intersection of Appleton St. and Main St. should have its function changed so it operates only as a means to allow a walk light to operate. This light should not have a stop and go cycle. This light constantly causes traffic to back up on to Tileston St. due to the cars parking on top of the trip wire on Appleton St (per member L. Pizzano)
 - g. Discuss the traffic light at the intersection of Second St. and Broadway must be timed properly so as to stop the grid lock caused by cars turning left off Chelsea St. onto Broadway. Plus, the green light cycle is too long on Corey St. This traffic light needs to be timed to the satisfaction of the Traffic Comm. The problem with this traffic light has been called to the attention of the city numerous times. (per member L. Pizzano)
 - h. Discuss that only peddle bicycles should be allowed in Everett. The bike lanes were designed for only their use. No scooters or any other type of nonregistered vehicle should be allowed in the city. Bicycles should have registration plates on them that would be issued by the police dept. The plates are to be affixed to the rear of the bike so as to be easily read. The rules for bicycle operation, as issued by the RMV, should be printed in the local newspapers to help inform the general public of the does and don'ts for operating a bike in Everett. (per member L. Pizzano)
